
Big Island Amateur Radio Club BIARC BUILETIN June 2006

Carter Davis, KH6FV and Jackson Tsujimura, KH6DQ came to Hilo Saturday March 4th from Honolulu to set up and inspect a new HF/VHF ICOM 706MKIIG transceiver provided by a grant to the Healthcare Association of Hawaii to hospitals in the state. There were a total of 14 units sent out. Hilo Hospital administrator John Halloran and Hospital employee Robert Watson, NH7XZ along with BIARC members Harry Nishiyama, KH6FKG; Robert Oliver, NH6AH and Bob Schneider, AH6J spent the morning checking out the system for Hilo Hospital. We plan on having it at BIARC Field Day so more people can become familiar with the rig.

Don't forget the Hawaii International Hamfest at Waimea on October 21.

Let me know of other events.

There are many writeups about BPL (Broadband over Power-lines) throughout the ARRL homepage. There is also an e-mail that was sent out to ARRL e-news subscribers telling about a push to have congress force compliance with existing laws about harmful interference. BIARC General Membership Meeting Minutes for May 13, 2006

The location was the Puna Congregational Church. Meeting was opened by President Bill Carlson at 2:05 P.M. The meeting started with self introductions and interesting comments by the members.

The Health and Welfare report included updates on the improving status of Julie Barnes and Mike Last. In addition, Al Pacheco, KH6IAA, Silent Key was remembered. Because of Al's long term dedication to the club and to 6 meter activity a motion was approved to offer his wife the service of handling his log books and QSL cards including answering continuing QSL requests.

The Field Day Mayor's Proclamation was displayed.

The program "An Introduction to the American Red Cross" was presented by Barney Sheffield.

Business Meeting: Secretary's report was approved as printed in the newsletter.

Treasurer's report stated that we now have 100 members and \$2,387.21 in the bank. Report approved.

Repeater committee report indicated that the replacement repeater for Kulani Cone is in final on the air burn in and ready to be installed. Permission from the landholder has been obtained. HELCO site access personnel safety renewal is needed.

The Mauna Loa UHF linking repeater needs attention, weather permitting. The UHF linking repeater near GS Camp is working. A tone encoder was recently installed on that machine. It was noted that CTCSS tones are being activated on the 2 meter repeaters as needed for noise control. The standard tone choice will be 100 Hz although some repeaters may have other tones

in use.

Maintenance and linking upgrade work by AH6GR on the Haleakala 146.94 machine for linking into the Hawaii Island network appears to be progressing. Last report is that the linking transceiver has been procured and, weather permitting, the antenna and duplexer will be reviewed prior to installation

Field Day information was given by Robert Oliver. The use of an IC 746 and a Ft 857 have been volunteered for field day use. The current plan is for two stations with band filters and a possible third station for new low time operators. Robert announced a plan for a homemade key display and competition during field day.

The Coconut Island social gathering May 27, 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. Pot Luck lunch around noon with the club providing the dinnerware and soft drinks.

Ted Brattstrom NH6YK proposed that a Special Event Station be established as part of the July 29 Rim Run activity. He would be available to support the activity but is returning just a week before the event. The subject was deferred for consideration by Sean Stueber who is organizing the Rim Run.

It was reported that The KIDS net will now meet only on Sunday on the 146.76 repeater at 7PM. A motion was made by Ron AH6HN, seconded by Solomon NH7ZE, with all approving, to set the Parry Memorial Fund aside for training and parts use as needed by the KIDS radio network to be administered by Solomon Singer.


International Ham Fest will be held the 3rd Saturday of October in Waimea at the Waimea Community Center at the park (1/4 mile from the school).

John Buck announced that a new ham club (Kohala Hamakua Radio Club) is being organized. The club will split meetings between Waimea and Hawi.


