
We had around 50 people sign the roster, but I know there were some who neglected to sign.

On September 4, 2006 Peter Sur ,of the Tribune, who writes This Day in History had an article under the year 1931 telling about the forming of the Hilo Amateur Radio Club at the home of Otis Hill owner of station K6AJA. This was the first club of its kind to be formed in Hilo. The club was formed for the mutual benefit of all amateur radio operators here, to bring them together for an interchange of technical information, to promote interest in amateur radio and to assist all beginners to become operators.


