Latest ... Thanksgiving Day there was a strong aftershock with little damage reported. The emergency nets came up immediately

Sunday October 15th we had a severe earthquake centered on the Kona side of the Island of Hawaii. No Tsunami was generated. No one was killed. There was a lot of damage in many areas. Power was out on Oahu for many hours. **The next day there was a severe Thunderstorm.** The SM was on the Mainland attending Pacificon during the trouble. The command structure worked. Kevin Bogan, SEC, and others spent long hours at State CD. On the Island of Hawaii all the repeaters stayed up. The 7088KHz emergency net was in operation almost immediately.

Clem Jung said that due to upcoming priority events, they will not re-start or conduct any ham class at State Civil Defense Diamond Head until May or June 2007 at the earliest


EXAMS:

Mascot Now a Silent Key


